

## Akins ECHS and Austin ISD Fine Arts Covid Protocol

### All participating students must have the following on file for 2020-21:

- Signed AISD COVID Waiver
  - The AISD COVID Waiver can be found on [www.akinseagleband.org](http://www.akinseagleband.org) home page.
- Physical Exam; can be carried over from 2019-20.
- Medical history
  - All returning Marching Band, Color Guard, Dance and Drill students must submit an updated 2020-21 UIL medical history form.
  - Students and/or their parents will be asked a set of questions and answers will be documented on the form.
  - Director conducting the screening will sign the medical history form under school official certifying that the screening was conducted.

### AEB First Day COVID Screening:

- Students will be asked the following questions:
  - Have you tested positive or been diagnosed with COVID-19?
  - Have you had contact with anyone with COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
  - Do you have any of the following symptoms: chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, or diarrhea.
  - Does anyone in your household have any of the symptoms above?
  - Temperature reading will be taken and must be below 100.0 °F.
  - After the First Day all students will need to use the AISD screening app. This is what we will use every day moving forward.

### Daily COVID Screening:

- Students will present to campus with a green check mark on their phone screen. Teacher verifies the date on the phone.
- Temperature reading will be taken and must be below 100.0 °F.
- If a student does not have the phone app, they will be verbally asked the screening questions.
  - In the past 24 hours, have you had any symptoms?
  - In the past 24 hours, has anyone in your household tested positive for COVID-19 or had any COVID-19 related symptoms?
  - In the last 24 hours, have you been in close contact or around anyone that has tested positive for COVID-19 or had any COVID-19 symptoms?
- All AEB student will need to download the AISD Screening App.

## Water

- All students must provide their own labeled, LARGE water jug full of water every day (a small gatorade bottle will not suffice).

## Face Masks

- Staff and students are required to wear face masks.
- Staff must wear a mask at all times.
- When indoors, a mask is to be worn at all times.
- When outdoors, a mask is to be worn at all times.
- Wind players may use masks with a slit at the mouth when required to play. At all other times, a regular face mask is to be worn (without slits). Wind instruments must have bell covers.
- Face masks must fit securely around the nose and face.
- **A gaiter can be used in conjunction with a face mask, but not by itself.**

## Social Distancing

- **Student check-in/arrival**
  - We will have two drop off areas
    - Entryway from South First Street into the Green Hallway Parking Lot
    - Entryway from South First Street into the Gymnasium Parking Lot
    - Temperature checks will be conducted as students exit drop off vehicles.
    - All drop off vehicles will need to wait until students' temperature is taken before leaving.
    - If the student temperature is over 100.00 then the student will need to go back home.

- All students will need to have completed the COVID-19 Screen & Go on the AISD App prior to arrival.
- After a student is permitted to enter rehearsal, they will then proceed to their designated “Performance Pod” on the field in the Fine Arts Parking Lot.
  - All instruments, personal items, cases and water jugs will be inside of the students performance Pod.
- Mask should be worn at all times.

#### During Rehearsal

- When not actively rehearsing, students should maintain 6 ft. of distance.

#### Water Breaks

- All students must provide their own labeled, LARGE water jug full of water every day (A small water bottle will not suffice).
- We will stagger water breaks between groups of students to allow for the greatest amount of social distancing possible.

#### Dismissal

- We will have a stagger dismissal (Flutes, Tuba, Seniors, etc)
- Students should maintain 6 ft. distance.
- Parents should remain in their vehicles during pick up and drop off.

#### Positive Screening Protocol

- Student calls/contacts you before coming to campus
  - Student must remain at home.
  - Collect information regarding the symptoms experienced and when symptoms first appeared.
  - We will notify campus administration.
- Student reports to campus and fails screening
  - Immediately isolate student from others.
  - Contact parents to pick up student.
  - Notify campus administration.
- If a student develops symptoms, all students in that group should be removed from participation until cleared to participate.

#### COVID-19 Positive Individual

- Student is COVID-19 Positive
  - Notify campus administration.
  - Maintain confidentiality: DO NOT notify any other parents, students, or staff members. Directives will be given by the Health Services Department.
  - Student must follow campus protocols for returning to campus.
